2. Aseta keskusyksikkö yhdistämistilaan.
3. Paina yhdistämisspainiketta kytkääksesi varoitin järjestelmään.
4. Katso keskusyksikön käyttöohjeesta lisätietoja.

Asennuspaikka

- Asenna häkätunnistin esim. makuuhuoneeseen suojaamaan häikämyrkytykseltä.
- Autotallillisissa taloissa asenna tunnistin lähelle autotallin sisäovea varoittamaan päälle jääneestä moottorista.

Älä asenna häkätunnistinta lähelle näitä:

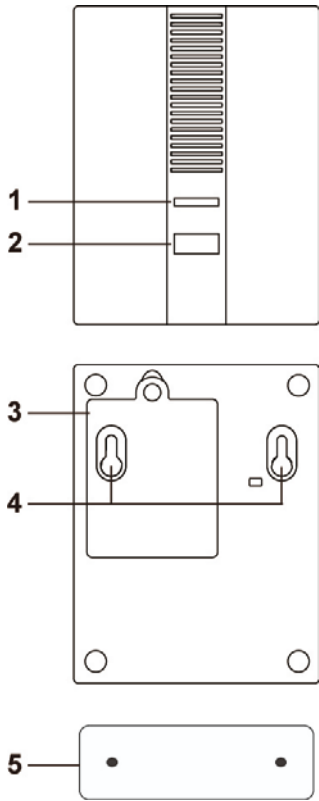
- Keittiö - liedien ja uunin päästämä hiilidioksidi voi aiheuttaa vääriä hälytyksiä.
- Takka/uuni – asenna ainakin 4.5 metrin päähän välttääksesi vääriä hälytyksiä.

Asennus

1. Käytä kahta asennusreikää asennustelineessä ja merkitse ruuvien paikat sen avulla seinään/kattoon.
2. Poraa kiinnityspaikat.
3. Ruuvaa asennusteline mukana seuraavilla ruuveilla kiinni.
4. Kiinnitä häkätunnistin asennustelineeseen.
